Whitby

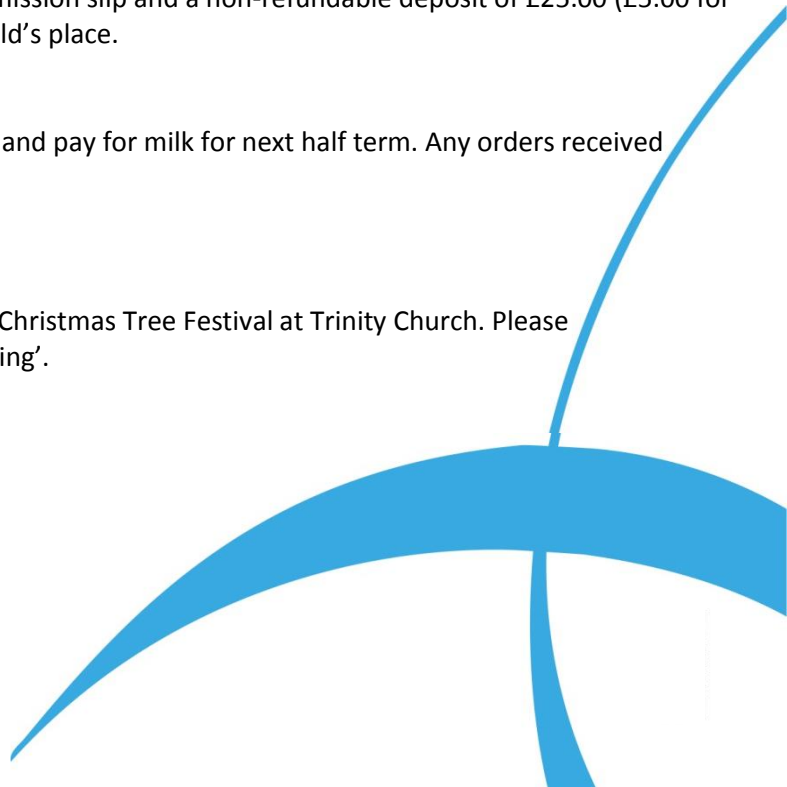
