Scholastic Book Fair

Thank you to all of you who have already visited our book fair. They will be collecting the book fair tomorrow so please visit us today after school from 3:15pm to 4:00pm in the blue hall. Remember you can now pay by card over the phone whilst at the book fair if you would prefer to do this.

Christmas Concerts

Last week, your child brought home a letter regarding Christmas Concert tickets. Please fill out your slips and return to the class teacher, with payment if required, as soon as possible to reserve your seats.

Please remember that, as in previous years, pre-school children can only attend the dress rehearsals and not the final concerts themselves.

Tickets are required for the Year 4, 5 and 6 productions, but not for dress rehearsals. The cost is £1 per ticket and there is a restriction of 2 tickets per family. Tickets will be allocated on a first come basis.

There is no cost for the Reception and Year 1 production or Year 2 and 3 production so you will not need tickets however, you will still need to fill in the reply slip to reserve your seats. This is again on a first come basis and we request that each family has no more than four seats per production and that family members attend only one performance. There will be a collection at the end of these performances.

All children will be watching each class performance during school, so therefore there is no need for children to attend the evening productions. As in previous years Mrs Gill will run a crèche for each of the evening productions for parents who are unable to access childcare.

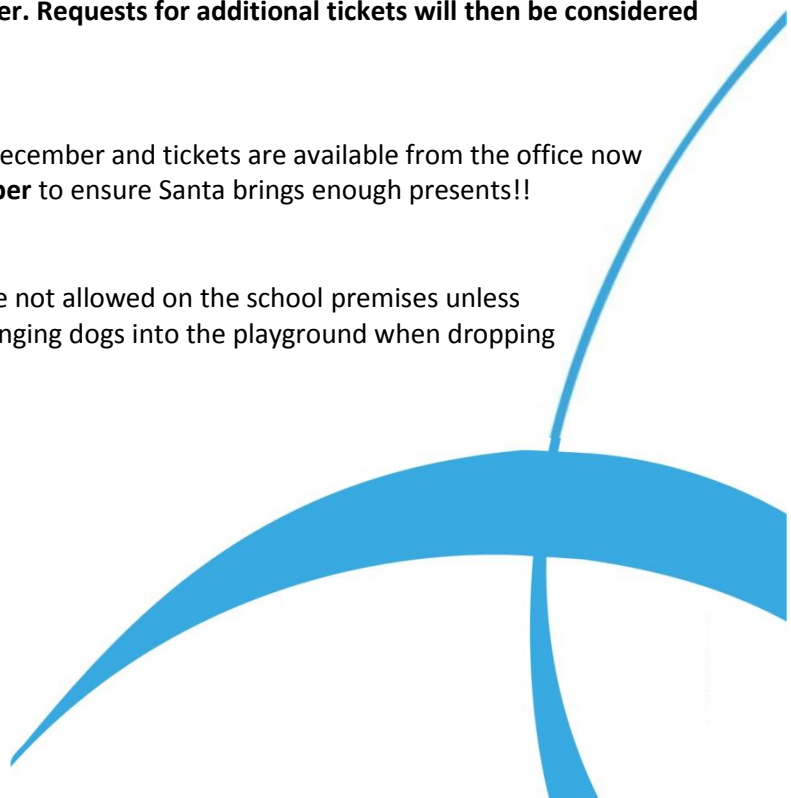
You must return your reply slips by Monday 4th December. Requests for additional tickets will then be considered after this date.

If your child usually has school dinners, you can pay as normal. If your child is eligible for free school meals, including universal free school meals, then you do not need to make this payment.
