

Dear Parents/Carers,

Thursday 30th March 2017

On Wednesday 26th April we will be taking part in a joint concert with Towngate Primary Academy in Ossett Town Hall.

Classes from each school will perform the song that they sang in the 'Last Choir Standing' competition.

The event will start at 1pm therefore we will be having an early lunch, children who usually have schools dinners will be provided with a packed lunch. **This is only if you return the attached slip by Monday 3rd April. This will still be at a cost of £2.05 unless your child receives free school dinners. If you do not return the slip then we will presume you are providing them with a packed lunch.**

The children are required to dress up on the day in 1960's themed costumes, however they will need to wear sensible shoes and a coat as we will be walking to and from the event. A minibus will transport the youngest children. Where possible we ask that any parents of children in Reception and Year 1 who are able to assist us by transporting their own child would do so. Please see attached letter regarding this. (Reception and Year 1 parents only)

Children will be walked back to school once they have performed. We will aim to be back to school for 3:15 however we cannot guarantee this. All adults are expected to stay for the whole show.

There is a limit on the numbers that can be accommodated in the Town Hall therefore tickets are limited to 1 per family initially. Tickets cost £2.00 each, this will cover the cost of the fee for the hire of the Town Hall. The closing date for tickets is **Friday 7th April**. Once initial tickets have been allocated then the spare tickets will go on sale from Monday 24th April. Please fill out the attached order form with your requirements.


Town Hall regulations stipulate that all adults must be accounted for therefore tickets must be presented on the day, you will not be able to enter the concert without your ticket.

In line with Town Hall guidance regarding infants attending the concert, if the infant is old enough to sit on their own seat then they will need to have a ticket. There will be spare tickets available from Monday 24th April. If they are too young to have their own seat then they can sit on parent's knees.

Infants are not allowed to sit on the balcony and in line with fire regulations exits must not be blocked by prams or pushchairs.

If at any point your child becomes unsettled then we ask that you be considerate and take them out of the concert. The children have worked very hard and we do not want any distractions to spoil their performances.
