Comic Relief Day

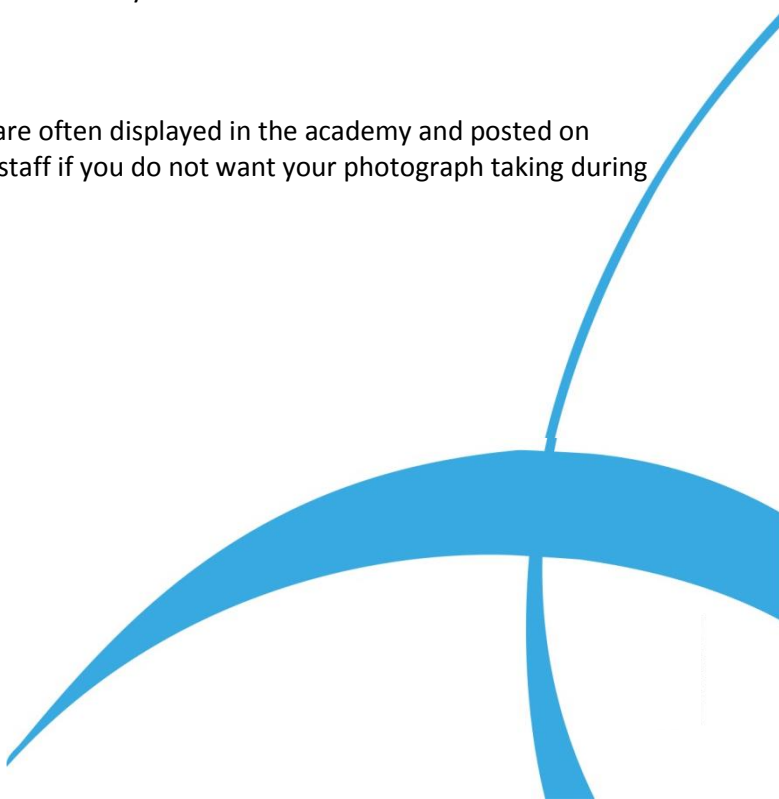
We hope you will join us tomorrow for the celebration of comic relief.
