### **Leavers Assembly**

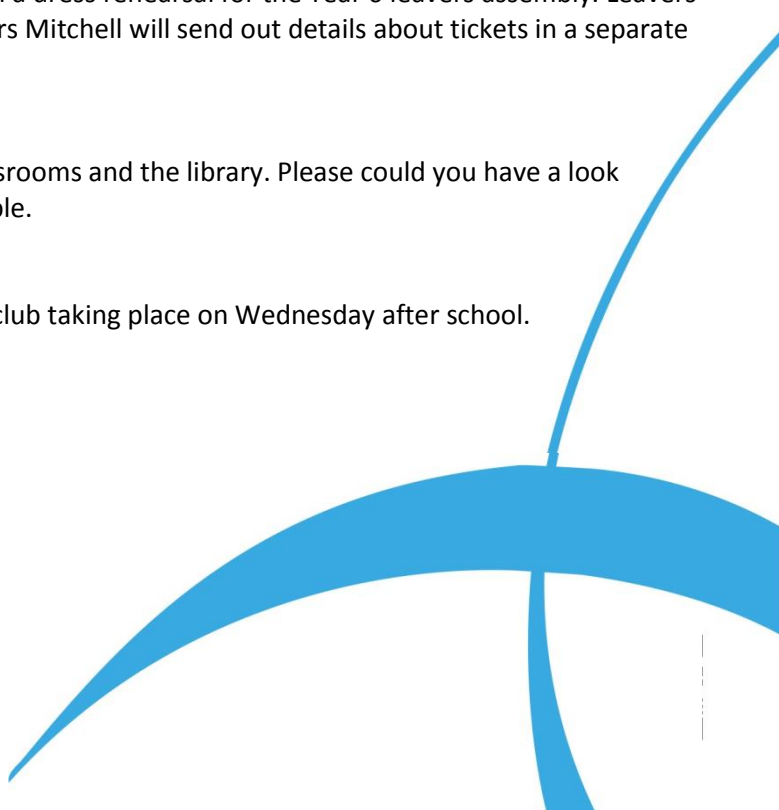
