Croft House

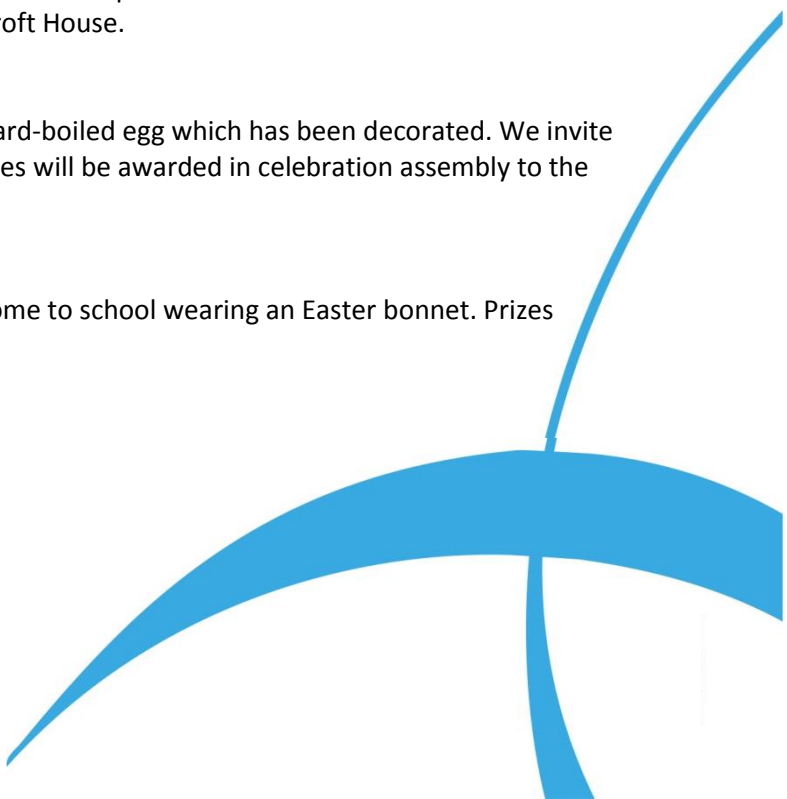
Next Wednesday Year 1 children will visit Croft House. We invite parents to make an Easter bonnet for their child which they can wear when they visit the residents of Croft House.
